




## World in recovery

## Metaverse Surgeries


- Metaverse will transform surgery, with robot-assisted surgery system moving to virtual reality

The KPJ Supplier Code of Conduct is to incorporate good business governance across the value chain

## **Environment**

"The supplier shall comply with all applicable environmental laws, regulations and standards as well as implement an effective system to identify and eliminate potential hazards to the environment.

We encourage our suppliers to support KPJ Healthcare's efforts to protect the environment and operate in an environmentally responsible manner through the products and services they deliver. In this regard, we also encourage our suppliers to develop policies on:

- a) Responsible use of resources including water and energy;
- b) Waste reduction;
- c) Pollution prevention;

## **Child labour**

"The supplier employs no children under the age of 15.
